PUT IT IN THE RECYCLE BIN

RECYCLE YOUR RUBBISH

Please Remember:

- Items must be clean
- Lids removed off bottles/jars etc
- Cans to have lids pushed in and the top squeezed together
- Paper to be bundled or bagged
- Scrap metal, computers, LPG cylinders and old appliances should be taken to the RRP for disposal
- Only listed items can be recycled
- Put items in the correct bins if using the rural drop-off sites

YOUR BIN MAY NOT BE EMPTIED FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- Not put out before 7am - though collection times may vary.
- Bin not placed correctly
Residential: Kerbside, to road as indicated on lid.
Rural: 2.5m off shoulder, facing front, on left, safe location
- Bin too heavy.
- Bin overfilled—lid not closed flush
- Bin too tightly packed.
- Bin contains unacceptable material ie: green-waste, recycling, hot ashes, liquids, flammables, explosive, toxic, hazardous or heavy objects.

Any bin not emptied will have a sticker placed on it explaining why (except if bin is put out too late)
