



## Makikihi Recycling

The Makikihi recycling drop-off point has now been established.

Coloured bins are in place at **Makikihi Motors** near the existing clothing bin, on State Highway One. A more suitable site is being sort and you will be notified of any changes.

This additional Council service will see the bins emptied weekly.

**Items other than the accepted recyclables shown will not be accepted or collected.**

Please ensure clean recyclables are deposited into the correct bins.

## What you CAN Recycle

### Tin Cans

You need to 'wash and squash'.

Hint: It's much easier if you wash food tins out straight away.

### Aluminium Cans

Just rinse out and squash.

### Paper

Newspapers and small numbers of glossy magazines and circulars are acceptable.

### Flattened Corrugated Cardboard

Please flatten the cardboard out so more can fit in the bin.

### Glass Bottles & Jars

**all colours accepted (place in correct bin)**

Broken or whole glass bottles and jars only. Rinse out and remove any tops or caps. No household, window glass, pyrex or drinking glasses allowed.

### Plastics

Wash out bottles and remove tops, which can go loose into the bin. This includes all grades of plastic containers. Larger plastic items can be taken to the RRP at the end of Racecourse Rd, Waimate.

## But we CAN'T Recycle

### Food or other organics

We can't recycle food or food contaminated waste yet. Food and greenwaste must either be composted on your property or greenwaste can be taken to the RRP at the end of Racecourse Rd, Waimate - a charge will apply.

### Other Glass

No household, window glass or glass connected to other material

e.g. light bulbs, mirrors

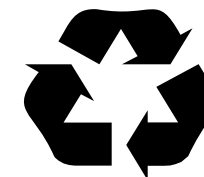
## WAIMATE RESOURCE RECOVERY PARK OPEN HOURS
