**Overview**

The Waimate Historical Society seeks a Heritage Fund grant in the sum of \$2,302.

**Background**

The Waimate Historical Society are undertaking a project whereby school aged children can experience what school life was like for their grandparents.

This will encompass the use of one of Waimate's Heritage buildings and share Waimate's past with others.

It is proposed that Edwardian style school uniforms be made up for children to be worn when the children visit the historic Douglas School to participate in heritage classes.

It is considered that the application falls within the following Council criteria for eligibility:

- Recording any aspect of the Districts heritage.
- Buildings and sites within public ownership, incorporated societies, etc.

**Eligible Projects**

- Archaeological and traditional sites.
- Buildings and sites with Historic Place classifications and / or listed in the District Plan.
- Other buildings or sites the Council consider worthy of assistance.
- Notable and Heritage trees.

An ineligible application may be for any other reason that the Council considers not appropriate for funding.

The Historical Society advises that the total project cost is \$3,180 with \$878 being contributed by the applicant.

The applicant is requesting consideration of a grant in the sum of \$2,302. The current balance of the fund is \$4,833.
