



Notification of Licensed Building Practitioner

The government has introduced new legislation known as restricted building work (RBW). These changes are designed to improve the quality of building work in New Zealand and to increase accountability and ongoing professional development of the building industry. The new rules apply to residential design and construction work that is critical to a building. As of 1 March 2012, RBW must be carried out or supervised by a licensed building practitioner (LBP). If RBW is involved in a project, it is the owner's responsibility to advise Council who the LBPs are and what work they are carrying out.
