WAIMATE URBAN WATER SUPPLY

September 2023

With warm temperatures and below average rainfall forecasted for Canterbury area over the summer this year. Residents on the Waimate Urban Water Supply are asked to look at their water needs, and usage.

Council wants you to enjoy summer activities and ask that you consider wise water usage when doing so. This is as simple as checking to see if your taps, toilet cisterns and hoses are not leaking or left running overnight.
